

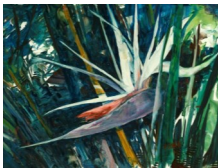
## The Early Bird gets the Workshop !

The Florida Artists Group Annual Exhibition is open to all members in good standing. Each artist may enter one art piece, which has been completed within the last three years.

The entry fee is \$ 35.00

Your art must be clean and presented in a professional manner. If your work is to be hung, be sure it is wired and ready to hang.

The maximum width allowed is 44 inches.  
No height or weight restrictions.

The museum's commission is 30 % on art pieces sold. The museum director reserves the right to reject any piece that is not of high quality, or does not represent the standards expected.

The museum takes no responsibility for damage to art work before, during or after the event. No art work can be removed before the show closes.
