Before coming to the United States Gudmund Vigtel lived in several countries besides Norway, Austria and Sweden. Attended college in Norway, art school in Stockholm and served in the Free Norwegian Air Force during the war. He worked with the United Press for several years during this period. As a graduate from the University of Georgia where he received his B.F.A. and M.F.A. Degrees he joined the staff of the Corcoran Gallery of Art, Washington, D.C. as Assistant of Installations. Soon after several promotions he was named Director of the High Museum, a post he has held for six years. Gudmund Vigtel has a very impressive record of achievements in the arts in this country.
