### **Juror of Awards**

### Lee Weiss

**Lee Weiss** is one of America's most distinguished watercolorists. She was born in Inglewood, California and attended California College of Arts and studied briefly with Alex Nepote and Eric Oback. Watercolors by Lee Weiss are in the permanent collections of the Smithsonian's National Museum of American Art, the National Air & Space Museum (NASA), the Phillips Collection and the National Museum of Women in the Arts in Washington, DC and in 26 other Public Collections all over the United States

Weiss was made a Fellow of the Wisconsin Academy of Sciences, Arts and Letters in 1985 and named a Dolphin Fellow of the American Watercolor Society in 1991. She is past President of the Watercolor USA Honor Society.

Her paintings have been exhibited in the Setagaya and Meguro Museums in Tokyo and the Saitama Museum of Art, Saitama, Japan numerous times between 1988 and 2008. She was one of 26 Americans with work in the First Invitational Exhibition of Contemporary International Watermedia Masters in Nanjing, China in 2007.

She received a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Watercolor USA Honor Society in 2009 and another from the Wisconsin Academy of Sciences, Arts and Letters in 2011.
